Da Vinci adapted his drawing skills to the lucrative fields of architecture, military engineering, canal building, and weapons design. He was determined to build "new machines" for a "new world." He developed hundreds of inventions, including early work with hydroelectric power.

Soul of an Artist

By the time he was 20, da Vinci was a celebrated artist, in part because his scientific and engineering disclipline gave his artistic subjects unmatched depth. Da Vinci believed that the artist must know not just the rules of perspective, but all the laws of nature.

illustrate them.
